GENERAL INFORMATION



Dates and time

The colloquium will start at 7:00 pm on Thursday November 18th, and will end at 5:45 pm on Saturday November 20th.



Registration

There are two types of registration for the colloquium : a first (at a cost of **175 \$ CDN**) which includes the Forum on Union Renewal (the opening session on the evening of Thursday November 18th and the Forum on Union Renewal on Friday November 19th) and a second (at a cost of **250 \$ CDN**) which includes the Forum on Union Renewal **AND** the Study Day on Union Research (the opening session on the night of November 18th, the Forum on Union Renewal of November 19th and the Study Day on Union Research on Saturday November 20th). These fees include the taxes, plenary and workshop sessions attendance, lunches, Friday's cocktail, refreshments, documents and simultaneous translation. You are invited to register as soon as possible and before the **12th of November**.



Discount

Students, retired and unemployed individuals can register at the discount rate of **90 \$**.



Accommodation

Participants are invited to book their own accommodation. To plan your stay in Montreal, please consult either one of the following sites : www.tourisme-montreal.org to book a room at seasonal price and www.travel.ubc.ca to benefit from the 'Canadian University' hotel rates (note: reserved to Canadian scholars). Participants are invited to book their room as soon as possible and, for better access to the Colloquium's venue, to pick a hotel in the centre area of the city (Downtown, Old Montréal and Old Port, Mount Royal and surroundings, Little Italy, Plateau Mont-Royal, Pôle des rapides, Quartier Latin, The Village).



Transportation

A - Automobile - www.mapquest.ca - zip code : H3T 2A7

HEC Montréal's Main Building is located at 3000, chemin de la Côte-Sainte-Catherine.

B - Train - www.viarail.com or 1-888-via-rail

You can go from Montreal's Central train station to HEC Montréal by:

Option 1: Taxi - Take a taxi outside of the Central train station towards HEC Montréal's Main Building, at 3000, chemin de la Côte-Sainte-Catherine.

Option 2: Subway - Alternatively, from the Central train station you can take the Subway (Bonaventure station, located under the Queen Elizabeth Hotel). In Montreal, the end stations of each line (orange, green, yellow and blue) indicate the route you must choose. In this case, take the orange line towards the Côte-Vertu station. Get down at the Snowdon station, and then take the blue line towards the St-Michel station. Get down at the Université de Montréal station. Getting out of the station (Boul. Edouard-Montpetit exit), take Willowdale Avenue and then left to HEC Montréal's Main Building.

C - Airplane - Arrival at the Montréal-Trudeau Airport (Dorval - YUL)

You can go from the Airport to HEC Montréal by: 1. Airport shuttle : Step 1 - Take the Aérobus shuttle La Québécoise, from Montréal-Trudeau Airport (Dorval - Platform # 1 for domestic flights and #6 for international ones) to Montréal (Central Bus Station Berri). Shuttles leave the Airport every 30 minutes. Follow this link to see the bus fares and schedule.

Step 2 - Choice between two options:

Option 1 : Taxi - Take a taxi outside of the Central bus station (Berri) towards HEC Montréal's Main Building, at 3000, chemin de la Côte-Sainte-Catherine.

Option 2 : Subway - Alternatively, from the Central bus station (Berri) you can take the Subway (located below the Bus station). In Montreal, the end stations of each line (orange, green, yellow and blue) indicate the route you must choose (download the Subway map - route marked in red). In this case, take the orange line towards the Côte-Vertu station. Get down at the Snowdon station, and then take the blue line towards the St-Michel station. Get down at the Université de Montréal station. Getting out of the station (Boul. Édouard-Montpetit exit), take Willowdale Avenue and then left to HEC Montréal's Main Building.

2. Taxi

Take a taxi outside of the airport towards HEC Montréal's Main Building, at 3000, chemin de la Côte-Sainte-Catherine. It will cost around around 30 \$ CDN.
